SUBJECT: GENERAL Operational/CALL
SPECIFIC Recommendation For Revision of KIBITZ-15 Net
Ref- EGF-A-850, EGF-A-926, SFRAN-1963

1. The following suggestions are made to implement reorganization of the present KIBITZ-15 net into an effective stay-behind organization designed to operate during the tactical phase (up to six weeks after hostilities begin).
 - a. Drop all agents except those W/T'ers completely or partially trained and their co-workers listed on Enclosure "1". This will provide five compartmented teams from the KIBITZ-15 net for a total of ten agents, who can be completed in a relatively short period of time.
 - (1) The majority of the agents to be dropped were recruited by KIBITZ-15 and are not known to KIBITZ-150. The disposal of these agents would be relatively simple without jeopardizing the security of the rest of the net.
 - b. Use KIBITZ-150 as a contract spotter and recruiter for the U.S. KIBITZ program for a maximum of eighteen months with the objective of developing up to twenty-five new and independent teams in strategic areas (see EGF-A-926). When his spotting and recruiting function has been achieved, KIBITZ-150 and family will emigrate to the United States. In the meanwhile, if these proposals are approved, he will change his area of residence in West Germany and drop all contact with dropped agents.
2. Enclosure "2" lists those trained or partially trained agents, who, together with their co-workers are to be dropped. The remaining forty people in the "net of sixty-three active agents" (EGF-A-676),
