1. The following information is forwarded to your office for your information:

A. CAPELIN stated in June 1952, in reference to his experiences in the Organization of Ukrainian Nationalists (OUN) and in the Abwehrstelle, that he recruited in November 1939 the following personalities in Yaroslav, Radimno and Peremysl (Ukraine). These individuals are categorized as follows:

- (1) Have remained in the homeland and would be willing to participate in the anti-Bolshevik cause;
- (2) Have remained in the homeland and would possibly help the anti-Bolshevik cause;
- (3) Have emigrated to Canada or the USA.
