Attachment: Para 1. Introductory remarks: I, as a counter-intelligence activist, have the conviction that Ukrainians, who have been under Soviet domination for a long time and who recently have been released (for reasons whatsoever) and sent to the West, should be observed with reservation since they may have been recruited by the Soviets. These persons will be ~~very dangerous~~ during their earlier periods in the emigration ~~and~~ ~~should be~~ ~~observed~~ in order not to give themselves away. Some of them will not be low level Soviet agents but they will place themselves in a position to disinform the emigration concerning the situation ~~in the homeland and in the emigration.~~ This will be of more value to the Soviets than if these people collected information concerning various organizations and persons.
