Subject: Ferenc K SZORUS

According to information in our files Ferenc KOSZORUS was a colonel in the Hungarian Army, whose troops protected Regent HORTHY from the Germans in 1944. After the war KOSZORUS became a member in a right wing Hungarian eigre organization, the LMBK, and served as the deputy in Munich to the leader of the organization, General Andreas ZAKO. In the LMBK, KOSZORUS is repated to have led internal opposition to the leadership of General/ZAKO, and one report states that KOSZORUS is one of two leading members in the LMBK who could be considered democratic.
