1. The undersigned, using the name of [] and [] met subject in the Fairfax Restaurant located at P and 21st streets on 12th Aug. 1952 at approximately 1130 hours.
2. Subject stated that he had sent \$240 to his wife in California and was expecting notification of her departure from California imminently. Subject was of the opinion that the \$120 he had left would suffice until next payment. His main concern re finances was repayment of \$100 debt incurred by him to Balogh, and payment for baggage upon its arrival. Rental needs for an apartment for his family are dependent on whether subject receives job described below.
3. Subject had appointment for job interview on 12th Aug. at the Childrens Home in Wash. D.C. Salary to include Board and small apartment.
4. Subject expressed strong concern for the necessity of including Catholic members in the proposed organization and stated that their absence would jeopardize the effectiveness of its work. He specifically mentioned Madgyesi, Mitschang Lajos, with whom he has been in contact. Subject seemed concerned about Borshy's role in the leadership of the proposed organization.
