Born in Liepaja. Father J. J. - a journalist executed by Toheka 1921. Graduate from Jelagva's II secondary school, studied in Latvia's University (Law) also in Army Officer's training School. During the German occupation was editor in Chief of the newspaper "TEVIJA". From 1944 worked for the "LATVIJAS BALSS" in Berlin, later for Latvian Central Comm. newspaper "LATVIJA" and since 1952 editor in chief of the same newspaper. Tried to immigrate to USA in 1951, but was rejected. Well known as writer of novels, has published several works: "Pusnakts viesis", "Sifuma", "Greizis rati" and many others. His wife is also a well known Latvian artist-painter.
