1. Upon reviewing the third document in Hungarian mentioned in para. 3 of Reference A, it was found to concern a plan for auxiliary implements (sic) for the preparation of firing plans for artillery. Presumably this is what "Peter" and Gabor FUREDI are referring to when throughout the [B] report and compte-rendu they speak of "Inventions de CZILCHERT" (Lt. Aurel CZILCHERT, private secretary to MAROSY in Spain). The document is of negligible intelligence interest and we are not sending it [] unless requested. "Peter", as we recall in a more recent report, indicated that le Chef (Gen. ZAKO) indicated that the "inventions" were not worth anything (naturally since ZAKO would not be permitting "Peter" to pass anything useful to the AVH in the first place.)

2. Also [] information, a translation was made of the Hungarian version of "Peter's" compte-rendu forwarded in reference B. It was found to be a more elaborate version of the [B] summary, but essentially the gist of the material was the same. Should [] desire it, this translation will be forwarded upon request.
