Attached for Headquarters is a single copy of an unnumbered [B] report dated 14 December 1956 which concerns contacts between [] and Tibor VARGA, A.V.H. officer assigned to the Hungarian Legation in Brussels, on 3 and 10 December 1956. Among the items of interest contained in the document are the following:

a) VARGA's supposition that the Legation in Brussels might cease to function as such and be incorporated with the establishment in Paris because of budgetary considerations. (Note: [] has received no subsequent information confirming this supposition.)

b) VARGA, under official orders, visited the refugee camp at Spa in December for the purpose of spreading propaganda and encouraging repatriation among the individuals there. (cf. OBBA-7216, 29 January 1957)

c) VARGA requested details about "fascist reinforcements" who went to Hungary via Austria from Western countries and how arms were procured for these individuals. He cited KOZMA (presumably Ferenc) as an example.

d) VARGA claims to be well-considered by Minister Jossef KOVACS.
