Abwehr OFFICER IN THE U. S. SECTOR OF BERLIN

DR. MUESKE

1. Last December ZIGZAG reported the existence of a certain Dr. MUESKE, said to have been a member of Abwehr I W1 (Industrial Espionage.)

2. The following information was submitted: Dr. MUESKE, in civilian life an official of the "Zentra-Markenuhr Verein" has been an officer of the Abwehr for several years. He belonged to Gruppe I-- active espionage--his main sphere of interest being industrial espionage. Dr. MUESKE had a number of agents under his control. The agents were predominantly posing as economists and made frequent trips abroad.

3. Dr. MUESKE's residence at 12 Im Schwarzen Grund, Dahlem, was visited by source last December. At that time subject was said to be in Western Germany.

4. Routine check by [ ] of above address revealed that Dr. MUESKE returned from Western Germany and is again at his home, 12 IM SCHWARZEN GRUND, DAHLEM, BERLIN.
