SUBJECT: Security Report.

This is to report that on 7 January, 1957 my wife, Mrs. Salme Kurgvel, was stolen her purse with a few dollars, and the key and address of our apartment, 3070, 34 Str. L.I.C. 3, N.Y. Apartment "I F". This happened in New York, in Subway, on my wife's drive to work. She suspected that a tall colored man took the purse, as he was the only person standing in a position where from one could have reached into her pocket where the purse was.

My wife reported the accident immediately to her supervisor and was allowed to go home. She phoned at once to another party in the same house and arranged that the apartment was taken under watch until her arrival.

The lock was changed the same day. The Police was informed. No suspicious person has been seen on the premises.
