1. Subject, in addition to other duties, has been an active member of the SR/DOB training staff. This letter is offered as an evaluation of Mr. Kurgvel's performance in this area.

a. Principle Duty Assignments and Evaluation

1. Senior Instructor - Agent Acquisition: - In my opinion one of the most competent men in this field that I've encountered. His foreign accent enhanced his presentations with the type of trainee's involved. Outstanding was his meticulous preparations in written and field exercises. Mr. Kurgvel's devotion to the task clearly exceeded normal requirements. (e.g.) During the present course, it is estimated that Mr. Kurgvel donated 60 hours of his personal time without any compensation.

2. Principle Instructor (FI) Covert Training - (4 week Program) - Performed in a creditable manner worthy of the desired professional requirement.

3. Assistant Instructor Covert Training - OTR - New York City: - As a participant in exercises which required immediate guidance and positive constructive evaluations, Mr. Kurgvel was repeatedly requested by the Chief, Covert Training Branch, OTR, to assist in other exercises.

1. Mr. Kurgvel was held in the highest respect by members of the SR/DOB Training Staff. At all times he readily and patiently passed on his past experiences, knowledge and
