SUBJECT: Participation in a Field Exercise of the Special Forces.

Members of the Estonian Veterans Association (Legion of Estonian Liberation) will participate in the field exercises of a unit of the Special Forces during the weekend of 5-6 May, in northwest part of New Jersey.

Starting point: the Firehouse in BRANCHVILLE, N.J. (on Route 206, some 8 miles north of NEWTON), on Saturday, 5 May 62, at 1030 AM, to report to Captain PFRGMMER.

No written information has been distributed among the members of the Legion. The members have been cautioned not to speak of this participation to the outsiders, because the Special Forces do not want to have any publicity in this matter.

The theme of the exercise: Guerilla warfare.

It is possible, that I shall participate, I would like to. However, the long distance from Washington to Branchville, about 240 miles if going direct way, or about 290 miles if going via New York, makes me hesitate - I would be too tired on Monday, and it would cost me too much money.
