SUBJECT: Employment Status, Aleks KURGVEL

Subject notified this office through his supervisor, [ ] that a long distance telephone call from New York concerning his cover employment might be made. He is negotiating in New York for the purchase of a new home and has contacted several banks for a loan. He has used as a reference his present cover unit and gave the banks the name of [ ] as the commanding officer of this unit and the cover telephone number and claimed that he has been employed with this unit since 1953. Central Cover records reflected employment with this unit since 1960. If one of the banks gives him the loan, there is a possibility that a long distance telephone call might be made to this cover unit, regarding his employment status. Central Cover Military [ ] was notified of the possibility of this long distance phone call. [ ] was given Kurgvel's current salary for the purpose of backstopping. \$8,045 per LPI
