SUBJECT: My TDY, Feb.-June 1964. Remuneration for Overtime Work.

1. I reported overtime work which I made during the TDY as follows:

- a) 167 hours, or 183 hours, if including the local holidays during which I worked while the other workers of the Station had day off, in six weeks, from 11 February to 21 March;
- b) 193 " " 233 " if including the local holidays as mentioned above, in seven weeks, from 22 March to 9 May;
- c) 58 " --- 58 in four weeks, from 10 May to 5 June.

Sum: 418 hours or 474 hours.

2. Up to now I have received paid for this overtime work:

- a) about \$ 600.--, together with the salary for the period ending 4 July, possibly for some 140 hours, I have no exact information;
- b) ----- \$ 157.72, together with the salary for the period ending 1 August, for 37 hours of the 58 hours worked between 10 May and 5 June. Thus, I have been paid approximately for 175-180 hrs.

3. Would you, please, kindly help me to get due information concerning the remuneration for the remaining overtime work of approximately 240-290 hours, as to:

- a) whether there will be more payments coming;
- b) whether, and in which measure, I am entitled to Compensatory Time Off for this part of the overtime work for which no money will be paid, and
- c) on which basis the abovementioned payments were made.

4. I need this information rather urgently, so that I could plan my personal life and work, especially the fall work at my house and garden in New York. In case that I am entitled for some Compensatory Time Off for the abovementioned overtime work, I herewith request Time Off on this basis for one or two weeks at your earliest convenience.
