SUBJECT : Verification of Contract Service for
Mario K. GIORDANO (P), Contract Employee

1. Initially, GIORDANO's service from 5 September 1951 to 23 February 1953 was categorized as independent contractor service. Based upon new information, it has now been determined that this period was actually performed in a contract employee status and is creditable for Civil Service Retirement purposes. Records of this office reflect GIORDANO was authorized the following compensation during the period:

2. Between 24 February 1954 and 31 December 1954 GIORDANO served as an Agency Contract Employee and this period also is creditable for Civil Service Retirement.

3. During period 1 January 1955 to 21 December 1967, GIORDANO also served as a contract employee. This period is not creditable for Civil Service Retirement purposes since he was subject to the provisions of Social Security.

4. From 22 December 1967 to date, GIORDANO has been a participating member of the Civil Service Retirement System. All of GIORDANO's service from 5 September 1951 to date is creditable for leave purposes.
