SUBJECT: Request for Information as Stated in Paragraphs 5 and 6.

Subject is a 65 year old Contract Employee of SB Division, who was recently informed that he is to retire on 30 June 1970 (this is in conformance with a new retirement policy established by Chief, SB Division). Mr. Kurgvel receives very little in the way of a pension since he will only have about 5 years under Civil Service, plus his Social Security.

Could your office please verify if the consular agreement noted in paragraph 6c still exists. If so, can Mr. Kurgvel legally request a pension for his period of service with the Estonian Army? How should he go about making such a request? Any information you can provide us on this matter would be greatly appreciated.
