MEMORANDUM FOR: Chief, EE-11
SUBJECT: Aleksel Kurguel
REFERENCE: Your request for clearance
dated 20 March 1951.

1. In view of the information and recommendation contained in a memorandum from the Chief, Special Security Branch, Inspection and Security Staff dated 30 June 1951, an Operational Clearance is hereby issued which will permit the utilization of Subject's services as an agent acting as Operational Staff Chief on operations out of Germany into Estonia under project LGHOMELY. This clearance is granted on the CONDITION that the results of any contemplated field checks will be sent to this office for transmittal to I&SS.

The files reflect in a report from Chief of Station, Karlsruhe, that in June 1950 Subject was not enlisted for operational work because of doubts about the security of his war time associate, Neumann, who *
