Dear Sir:

The I.R.O. in Wentorf is preparing the closure of its activity. All the employees have received termination notices with effect from 30 September, after which date we may be re-employed on temporary base only. In connection with this arrangement I will go on leave from 1 September.

There has nothing more happened in my emigration affair since I sent you my last letter on 4 August. In view of the steps already taken in my emigration matter I have to count with the very probable final rejection of my application. Therefore I have to take other steps for settling my future life.

Although I have not get from you any definite word, I feel myself still bound with the promise which I gave you in Wentorf in February and repeated later in Munich. I don't want to obtrude myself to you, but I like have my desk cleared. Therefore I ask you to inform me whether and when you, knowing my difficulties, will start working with me, whether you will do this even in case that I will not be able to immigrate into the States, and on which conditions then (especially concerning the security of my family). I could come to Munich at any time beginning with 1 Sep, when you like to discuss the matter orally.

My time has run short. I can't stay with I.R.O. for long any more. I will have to do many trips during September, one probably even to Sweden. I have to draft my time-table duely. Therefore I ask you to inform me of your decision before I will go on leave. By phone you may reach me the last on Friday, 31 August.
