

It is respectfully requested that I and my family be granted permission to reapply for immigration to the United States within one year after exclusion by the Board of Special Inquiry.

For your information I was found inadmissible to the United States by the Board of Special Inquiry convened at Hamburg, Germany on July 31 1951 under Sections 10 and 13 of the Displaced Persons Act of June 25, 1948 as amended, and my wife, Salme, and minor son, Rein, were found inadmissible to the United States under section 10 of the Displaced Persons Act of June 25, 1948 as amended.

I have this date notified the officer in charge of the Immigration and Naturalisation Service, Munich, that my appeal from the excluding decision of the Board of Special Inquiry is being withdrawn.
