1. Aleksis KURGVEL, Estonian army captain born on 13 September 1904 in Kuresaare, Estonia who served during World War II with I.G. Farben in Berlin, Abwehrstelle I in Tallinn and Aufklärungskommando 102 in Tallinn.
2. Otto Bong, Latvian volkdeutsche born in Malmo, Sweden on 4 May 1918, who served during World War II in Abwehrstelle Ostland and FATEBPP 212.

FRAN NOTE: Upon receipt of this memo, MOB was queried on the reason for requesting this type trace.
