1. It is requested that subject be granted a covert security clearance to permit him to be used in the United States as a contract agent trainer, by October 1952.

2. Subject is presently employed by DYGLAM in Germany. His wife and child are residing in New York City. Subject was excluded from emigrating as a DP under Section 10 and 13 of Public Law 744. As a result it may become necessary to request subject's immigration into the United States under Section 8 of Public Law 110.
