SUBJECT : Information Obtained from AEPIONEER 6

1. Pursuant to a verbal request from your office, AEPIONEER 6 was asked the following questions:

- a. While he was working for this organization in Sweden in 1951-52, did he contact a person named KALA?
- b. While in Sweden did he, AEPIONEER 6, use the name "Thompson"?
- c. If he did not use this name, is he aware of anyone who did, or does he know anyone named "Thompson"?

2. AEPIONEER 6's answers were as follows:

- a. He believes he met a man named KALA in Germany. This man, now about sixty years old, was an Estonian Major. He was attached to an Estonian Labor (Guard) Company working for the Americans near Nurnberg. AEPIONEER 6 does not recall ever meeting anyone named KALA in Sweden.
- b. AEPIONEER 6 has never used the name "Thompson".
- c. AEPIONEER 6 has a good friend in Estonia named "Thompson"; however, he has not seen this friend since 1940 and can recall no one by that name in Sweden.

3. AEPIONEER 6 was told that this information was needed in order to clarify our records. He gave this information readily.

4. Should the above information have any bearing on the present use of AEPIONEER 6, this office would appreciate notification as soon as possible.
