Subject was educated in Tallin war schools and graduated from the military academy there.

Subject has a vast amount of military and intelligence experience having worked in the Estonian Intelligence Service, Finnish and German Military Intelligence Service, British Intelligence from 1929 to 1949 and with the U.S. Intelligence since 1950. Subject received highest rank of Captain in 1934 while working for the Estonian Intelligence Service. His 28 years of intelligence experience has included analysis and compilation, intelligence liaison, CE Instruction, W/T, training and recruiting, assessment, and handling of Russian, Baltic, German and U.S. Agents. He also assisted in the dispatch of agents into the USSR. From 1951 to 1953 he was utilized by CSOB as an operational assistant.

Subject was brought to the U.S. by CIA under PL-110. So far Subject has been assigned to two DOB projects instructing in Tradecraft and Fieldcraft subjects. Subject has many favorable efficiency reports in his files. He is said to have a highly developed sense of duty and responsibility.

Subject is married and has two sons, one of whom is attending college in South Carolina and the other attends high school.
