Extractions from reports that are in the Contact Division Files

KUSZEL is a survivor of the Katyn massacre.

Politically he is a Radical, he is opposed by the Moderate Policy Group

In February of 1948 KUSZEL was recruiting volunteers ostensible illegal entry to Argentina, but he was actually recruiting for illegal entry into Spain

In May 1948 KUSZEL dispatched two agents into the BSSR (They were dispatched as Polish repatriots). In December 1949 one of these exfiltrated with the following message:

- a. The Byelorussian resistance movement has sufficient arms and ammo of German make for the foreseeable future.
- b. The resistance movement has 10 radio sets.
- c. The movement, as is the case with the Soviets in the Byelorussian SSR, are critically short of medical supplies.
