1. Source claims that the ENR has a counter-espionage apparatus. This matter should be investigated and, if true, this apparatus should be tapped by CIA.

2. Source maintains that the ENR has individuals who are scholars of the Soviet Union and particularly of the Byelorussian SSR and who are also capable of writing in English. If this is so, then a group should be organized from the ENR which would submit to us reports on government, party, personalities, etc., in order to enlarge our knowledge of the BSSR as well as for post-war exploitation.

3. Source affirms that the ENR has no psychological warfare effort of its own. It has attempted to have a Byelorussian program included in the VOA but has failed. At this time it is attempting to cooperate with SOBR in order that it be included in that radio program. The ENR, however, is too poor to initiate a psychological warfare effort of its own.

4. Sometime in December the ENR is holding its annual plenum and ABRAMCHIK is scheduled to attend. This has been substantiated by a
