SECRET

1.-Subject is an old emigrant, former officer in the White Army, who has been residing in Berlin since 1921. During the war he worked in the "Foreign Section" of the Antikomintern, - Auslandsabteilung. This section had as its aim ant-bolshevik propaganda directed at the west.

2.-REZCHIKOV was captured by the Red Army in Berlin and turned over to the NKVD. It appears that he denounced to them his former chief Baron KRUDNER-STRUBE, who was either shot or taken to the USSR. He was able to interest the NKVD somehow and soon appeared at liberty in Berlin. He soon left Berlin for DRESSEN where he attended and graduated from a special Soviet intelligence school. (It is reported that former emigrants are being trained at this DRESSEN school.) He returned from DRESSEN wearing a Soviet uniform.

3.-Lately he turned up at POTSDAM, where in meeting his acquaintances of former days he highly praised his new masters. However, at an outing at club BALKAL in Berlin, where he formerly passed many gay evenings with his former best friends, Baron KRUDNER and SHAKELBERG, he became hysterical and completely broke down. He was led away by his friends without saying a word.

4.- REZCHIKOV is clever, intelligent, speaks five languages, and will undoubtedly make an excellent and dangerous Soviet agent. He feels that the dye is cast and will work loyally for his new masters in spite of his sentimentality for former times.
