Dear Viktor,

I received your best wishes and thank you. We all send you our greetings and good wishes.

Judging from your letter, you are cheerful and keeping well. I am very glad that you are in good health and that everything is all right in your work.

During this time I have been thinking a lot. I am alone at home in the daytime. No one is there to disturb my mood and I do not have to adapt myself to the general frame of mind, so I become calm and cheerful.

Don't you think too that your [friend] is inclined toward something that costs a lot of money and disturbs the tranquillity and condition of the organism, and ruins the health? If this has not occurred to you before, then observe it quietly and without getting upset.

I did not want to talk to you about it. However, I knew that all these excesses were very prevalent in postwar Germany. To judge such an addition and weakness is impossible. Usually, it is very easy for people who are not sensitive, to criticize and condemn. During the last few years we always had this lack of understanding between us.

No drinking party is worth what I am telling you about. I was terribly worried about you. Through ignorance, it is easy to fall into temptation. When you used to be beside yourself, I told you it was caused by the accident when you were injured in the head. Be careful, Vyshkan, stand steadfastly and firmly on your feet.

And do you know something else? Do not drink coca-cola [mixed] with vodka together with your friends. It goes straight to the brain and terribly weakens your organism.

Today I received a letter from ^{daughter} Lyalya and one from ^{granddaughter} Katya written by her personally, which made me laugh.

When I saw how Zina and Zhenya were making packages to be mailed to their children, I felt very sad. Suddenly the next day your money arrived. Immediately I ran to the bank, received the money, and went shopping for lightweight toys. I bought a large hen; two dancing chickens with little German hats on their heads; a gentleman and a lady; and a tiny, almost weightless, bunch of artificial flowers. In the shop I requested the most lightweight little carton. I came home quickly, packed all this, and went to the post office. All this cost 1,400 Finnish marks. I returned home happy and satisfied.

It appears that these things cannot be found in Pakistan and the children were terribly happy to receive such a present.

Katyusha asked me in her letter: "Grandma, was there any candy in the hen? We did not find anything in it." It was impossible to send a box of candy, because it would cost thousands of [marks] and besides it would melt on the way. It appears that they do not see any candy there. Anything that melts is not sold [in that country]. If there were a branch of "Air France" here, I would have gone there and maybe would have managed somehow to send [candy] to them. However all airlines here are Swedish.

On the first day of Easter we visited Zina. She had some other guests besides us. On the second day of Easter they were our guests. Before the holiday, Tata arrived. She is very tall and pretty, and very nice. Yesterday, Tolya came alone. He also is extremely tall, very quiet and nice.

Zhenya TEREKHOV is also a very nice fellow. Zina is not well. Her hip was broken, and a spike was inserted into the hip; as soon as the bones grow together, it will be removed.

I feel much better. The pain is more or less bearable. The last time I visited the doctor, he was pleased with himself and with me. And I was not sorry to pay 6,000 for the visit and all the medicines.
