a. He was formerly a Captain of the White Russian Army.			
b. From 1928 to 1939 he lived as an emigre in Paris.			
c. In []			
c. In 1940 he went to Berlin where he worked for the Anti-Comintern.			
d. After 1945 he lived first in Wangen-Allgaeu, then in Munich where he worked for several western intelligence services.			
e. In early 1956 he took up contact with Gleb UMNOV. CATUSK considered him an intelligence peddler and took no steps to utilize him.			
f. UMNOV had sporadic contact with Subject until May 1961 when the contact was terminated.			
g. CATUSK gained no pertinent information on Subject during that contact. At no time did they have any indication that he was working for the Soviets.
