The above named individuals underwent a routine medical examination at my office on 28 July 1952.

1. Christine (A-O-285): No significant history; Physical examination, entirely negative; Laboratory studies, including chest x-ray, urinalysis, and serologic test, were all within normal limits; Disposition, physically fit.
2. Anton (A-O-284): No significant history; Testes noted to be questionably undescended on physical examination; Laboratory Studies, including chest x-ray, urinalysis, and serologic test, were all within normal limits; Disposition, physically fit.
3. Rita (A-O-283): History; Scarlet Fever at 8 years of age, Appendectomy at age of 15, Pneumonia at 20 years of age. Physical examination revealed only an appendectomy scar. Laboratory Studies, including urinalysis, serologic test, and chest x-ray, were all within normal limits. Disposition; physically fit.
