1. Reference is made to your request that this office arrange to have Iggard BERZINS contacted to reassure him that the Subject's visit with him was made in the course of official business and that BERZINS had no cause to fear for his safety or that of his family.

2. This confirms previous verbal advice that this office arranged to have a representative of the Counter Intelligence Corps, US Army, contact BERZINS. BERZINS was reassured regarding the Subject's visit with him. CIC advises that BERZINS appeared to be convinced that the Subject was a genuine representative of the Department of Army.

3. It is understood that you will work with Central Cover Branch to improve the Subject's cover. In addition, you will brief the Subject regarding his cover and the manner in which he should handle contacts of this type.
