- [] a) Delivered Soviet Latvian periodicals, and office supplies
- [] b) Instructed Churgin to translate the letter intercepts which contain ~~maximum~~ operational possibilities. The letters of no operational value should not be translated any more, and he will receive new instructions within 7 days (as soon as received from SR/6) what else to extract from them besides the purely routine addresses in the Latvian SSR.
- [] c) Churgin was informed that as of now [] is his immediate and highest superior, with [] remaining as an intermediary
- [] a) Informed [] on the changes and happenings at Radio Madrid as transmitted to him by [] (Letter translated and on file under Procect AEFLAG)
- Churgin: a) Informed that he will see the Latvian Minister to USA for personal discussions.
- b) Inquired if it would be possible to meet with [] in the immediate future to discuss his personal matters and his contemplated assignment. [] agreed to arrange the meeting as soon as possible. (This request was passed on to [])
