- [] a) Informed CH. that although he is in social contact with [] (who is Churgin's first C/O) not to discuss any of his personal problems in regard to his future status with [] unless [] asks about it, in which case [] conversation with Ch. will be cleared through us.
- b) Gave Ch. his income tax return of \$ 15.-

Churgin: a) Gave [] a contact report in regard to a recent meeting between Churgin & the Latvian Minister to the USA. Churgin further explained that because of personal reasons he wanted to give his contact report directly to [] In regard to this Churgin was instructed that in the future if I am unavailable, he should feel free to call up [] (True name []) to arrange a personal (private) meeting, and that they will be more than glad to receive material which he does not wish to transmit to us through []
