SUBJECT : Churgin Family Problems

~~Churgin stated that his family life is not what it ought to be. He had thought that~~
if was to remain here his wife would also remain in the DC area to establish a dental practice here. However this is not so, for his wife and he just cannot get along. They have constant arguments and even their children notice it. His wife does not like DC and is complaining that Churgin because of his work has ruined her life. According to Churgin his wife has a job offer to work as partner in a dental office in Philadelphia, Pa with a promised salary of \$ 12,000.- per year. Churgin stated further that his family ~~family~~ difficulties started already soon after their marriage while still in Latvia. If Churgin's wife goes to Phila, they have agreed that that both of the children would go and stay with the wife. Due to the family problems Churgin indicated that he is willing to go to FROB and in fact he would prefer it instead of staying here. Churgin said he realized that he because of his wife is causing as quite a bit of trouble. [] indicated that he should not feel that way because this is something that cannot be helped. Subj. asked [] not to discuss his family problems with any body else and may be not even with [] if the word has been passed to FROB already that he is not going over. [] replied that irregardless of the situation [] will have to be informed in order to be able to do something in his case. [] indicated to Churgin that he did not know if the cable has gone out yet which stted that Churgin is to remain here. [] informed Ch. that he will check with [] in regard to what can be done on Subject's behalf
