- [ ] Congratulated [ ] on the new arrival in his family - a girl Ingrid Aina.
- b) Gave [ ] Soviet Latvian publications, gave Churgin 2000 index cards to continue his work on Riga telephone directory, sterile typing paper and scotch tape.
- [ ] a) Informed [ ] that he didnot go to the Latvian Song Festival in NY
- b) Informed that ALA has a conference during the weekend of 2- 3 August in NY [ ] authorized [ ] to go to NY : to attend the conference, to contact President of the Institute in order to get an estimate on the possible cost of printing Djilas book, and to contact R.T. Goforth (p). [ ] will be reimbursed for the trip upon his return for it was impossible to get the travel money on such a short notice.
- c) [ ] informed that [ ] family is ready to leave USA for Spain on a two weeks notice. [ ] estimated by checking with travel agencies that it would cost apr. \$ 1000.- to \$ 1100.- to get ( ) family over to Spain. [ ] inquired about the following prior to sending ( ) family over:
- 1) Could ( ) wife get her naturalization papers here in DC prior to her departure, and if so is there a waiting period? Could ( ) wife get naturalized in DC right away, after her return prior to the expiration of the one year in overseas? Harry to check on this with Alien Affairs Branch.
- d) Gave [ ] the bank book in order to make out the quarterly AEFLAG account ing.
- e) Gave [ ] the translation of [ ] letter dated 29 July 1958 (Filed in AEFLAG ops) *SUPPOR*
