SUBJECT : AEFLAG ops discussions

PARTICIPANTS: [ ] [ ], Churgin (p) and [ ] (alias)

COPIES TO : none

- [ ] [ ] a) Informed that he escorted the [ ] family to the Port of New York and put them on the S/S Constitution without many difficulties. [ ] is writing a Memorandum for the Record on instructions and guidances which he has given to [ ] family
- b) Gave [ ] the accounting on his trip to New York
- c) Inquired about the hospitalization money which is due to him, in connection with the child birth in his family. [ ] promised to check.
- d) Inquired about his and [ ] correspondence file. [ ] promised to return it at the next meeting
- e) Inquired if any other latvian speaking person is reading the above mentioned file and the Madrid latvian broadcasts. [ ] replied that nobody else is reading it, however the previous broadcasts which [ ] translated have been read by other people, and that the white [ ] comment sheets are taken off prior it is given to somebody else. No more questions were asked about this subject.
- [ ] [ ] a) Informed [ ] that a thorough study is being made ~~am~~ about our Madrid broadcasts ~~xxxxxx~~ in regard to the audibility as well as contents of the broadcasts, and that in apr. 2-3 weeks we should have the report finished. At this time we will be able to give [ ] better guidance and instructions on how to improve the ~~xxxxxx~~ broadcasts. In view of this [ ] was told that a qualified propaganda man is working on this. Upon this [ ] inquired if he will be able to meet this propaganda man, [ ] replied that he thinks that [ ] will meet this man in the near future.
- b) Instructed [ ] to translate and to transmit to [ ] the propaganda guidance in re to the October Revolution, and as given to [ ] by Jack.
- c) Instructed [ ] to account for [ ] family's travel in accordance with Agency regulations.
- Churgin: a) Inquired if [ ] has received the street indexes to the Riga City plans, which he needs in order to complete his work on the RIGA telephone directory. [ ] replied that the street indexes together with the maps will be given to him as soon as received
- b) Churgin gave [ ] the latvian newspaper in Germany "LATVIJA" article which per-
