SUBJECT : Churgin's contract, Info on Radio Rome  
and AEFLAG ops discussions

PARTICIPANTS: [ ] [ ]), Churgin (p) and [ ] [ ]

Churgin: a) Inquired if could take leave from 15 - 17 October prior to his departure for Frankfurt, for he would like to help his family move to Lancaster, Pa. [ ] informed Ch. that so far he does not see any reason why he would not be able to leave at that time, and that we would try to get all his training in before that date.

- [ ] [ ] b) Informed Churgin that we would try to arrange some training for him in S/W, Defensive Audio Surveillance, Interrogation, Interviewing, Eliciting and Counter Surveillance; however due to the limited time available we do not know if we will be able to give him all of this.
- b) Informed [ ] to go ahead and take out a passport for he might have to go to Europe on a short notice, in regard to the assessment of the two Soviet Latvians in Belgium. [ ] was instructed further that he will get a physical examination during the coming week, as well as various types of shots (vaccination).
- [ ] [ ] c) Informed [ ] that he has given quite a bit of thought about the Radio Rome broadcasts and that he thinks that we probably could use the former Latvian diplomatic in Sweden Mr. Tepfers as a go between to find out all about the radio broadcasts from Rome, and that probably Mr. Tepfers could get a letter from the Latvian Minister to Great Britain Mr. Karlis Zarins which could give him an "official" backing. [ ] to check this with [ ]
- b) [ ] gave [ ] \$ 22.08 tax refund which he is to mail to [ ]
