SUBJECT : Request for Processing Dependents of SR Division Contract Employee, Freds Launags, for PCS Overseas Travel.

REFERENCE : SR Division Request for Processing of Freds Launags, dated 9 September 1958.

1. It is requested that the dependents of Freds Launags, be processed for PCS overseas assignment. Mr. Launags departed for PCS assignment in Frankfurt, Germany on 31 October 1958. Subject's contract, effective 1 October 1958, provides for dependent travel as follows: "Para. 3. Travel (C) For your dependents, your household effects, and your personal automobile to your permanent post of assignment overseas, if such travel is initiated prior to 1 October 1959;". Factors pertinent to the dependent travel are provided below:
