SUBJECT : Accounting for Operational Advances to  
Raymond S. CEURGIN (P) under Project AERANKEYE

1. Subject was sent PCS to Frankfurt Operations Base on 20 October 1958. He was subsequently sent home by the field due to peculiar behavior, arriving in the United States on 10 August 1959.

2. Upon arrival at Headquarters, Subject was examined by the Psychiatric Staff and it was their determination that CEURGIN was suffering from an acute paranoid-schizophrenic reaction while overseas.

3. While overseas, Subject received advances of operational funds amounting to \$923.01. When asked for an accounting for these funds, CEURGIN explained that he bought drinks for various and sundry people in different bars and restaurants and paid musicians in these restaurants to play songs. Subject stated he considered it necessary to keep up his morals and that of the German people. CEURGIN was not able to rationally account for the above funds and the Psychiatric Staff has informed us that he was not responsible at the time he spent these funds. He was advanced \$314.00 traveling expenses for PCS travel to Headquarters. He has accounted for \$415.05 for travel. This will reduce the operational advance from \$923.01 to \$821.96. We consider this to be the best accounting that Subject will be able to render.
