Dear Freds:

Your letter from Los Angeles has reached me, and I am surprised to hear that you are in that beautiful city of Los Angeles. As you know, I had not heard from you since last August and had wondered where you might be.

In your letter it is noted that you wish to return to Oregon for about two weeks at the most and then you might possibly go to Seattle. You asked as to whether there might be funds left in your "expense" box. I am sorry to tell you that federal funds have been drastically cut and that there are no other funds for you. I have also been asked to tell you that you, as a citizen of the United States, are responsible for your actions and that you must, accordingly, fend for yourself.

As I remarked to you in my communication to you last year, your funds had just about been exhausted and that following the last forwarding of funds to you there were no more available.
