

6. Hartmann, LAUTERBACHER. In the light of request in DIR 64936 for background information on the present LAUTERBACHER investigation in connection with the crimes trials at Hudon, I led Fleming around to a discussion of the LAUTERBACHER case among several others that we touched upon. In mentioning to Fleming that we had heard that LAUTERBACHER is being investigated, I asked if he had any information that could throw light on LAUTERBACHER's present activities and possibly involvement in the "trials". Fleming disallowed any knowledge of LAUTERBACHER's present whereabouts or other activities and reiterated that LAUTERBACHER had been summoned for trial in 1963. Fleming agreed to check into this and stated that he would let us know what he finds out. He asked if by any chance we had any operational interest in LAUTERBACHER and I informed him that that was definitely not the case, particularly in the light of what we already know about LAUTERBACHER's generally unsavory background and habits.
