1. Reference is made to IO Division memorandum of 1 September 1955 requesting that a Proprietary Approval be granted Subject for the position of editor under Project TITONIC in Germany. In this connection, we would refer you to our memorandum of 30 June 1955 wherein we recommended in connection with your previous request that caution be exercised in the handling of Subject in view of Subject's alleged inability to keep confidential information to himself and of his being regarded by some as a rumormonger who talks excessively.

2. In accordance with the provisions set forth in Clandestine Services Instruction No. 10-5 and Field Regulation 10-215, a Proprietary Approval is granted for the covert use of the Subject as described in your request as set forth in paragraph #1, above.

3. This approval becomes invalid in the event the Subject's services are not utilized within 60 days of the date of this memorandum.
