MEMORANDUM FOR: SECRETARY OF THE PROJECT REVIEW COMMITTEE

SUBJECT: Project LCCASSOCK

1. This is to advise that this date I have given preliminary approval to Project LCCASSOCK in the amount of \$[] for FY '54, final approval being subject to approval of an Administrative Plan and the concurrence of the Office of the Comptroller in the project's FY '54 budget as required by the proposed Administrative Plan. It was included for the same amount in the EE Division's FY '54 Program as approved by DCI, and funds are available. The Comptroller has been advised accordingly.

2. LCCASSOCK is a continuing activity which heretofore has been financed with LOLAVER and, more recently, ZRCANDY funds. Its objective is to maintain and further stimulate pro-Western attitudes amongst the people of East Germany. It involves the subsidy of a controlled private group in West Berlin which produces and distributes falsified editions of bona fide East German publications and performs other services in the propaganda media field directed at specific target groups. It has been quite successful in its distribution operations inside East Germany and is believed to be an effective asset.

3. The finds approved herein are to finance its activities during the second half of FY '54. However, this action in no way constitutes a commitment regarding the project's FY '55 budget level.
