MEMORANDUM FOR: Deputy Director (Plans)

SUBJECT: Revised Administrative Plan for EE
Division Subsidy Project LCCASSOCK

I. Objectives of the Project

1. The objective of this project is to sustain and encourage, through the use of propaganda media such as publications, pamphlets, leaflets and stickers, popular resistance to the Communist regime of East Germany and its philosophy.

II. Instrumentality

2. The project instrumentality is comprised of an indigenous anti-Communist group located in West Berlin which produces and disseminates to East Germans various types of anti-Communist propaganda.

III. Background

3. The LCCASSOCK organization began operations in anti-Communist propaganda activities in April 1952 with HICOG funds under the administration of the German Mission. The project's approval based on CIA funds dates from February 1954 to the present. Since its approval in February 1954, project LCCASSOCK has produced an average of 20,000 copies of propaganda material per month for distribution in East Germany. High indications of distribution and effectiveness of the propaganda has been received in the form of letters from East Zone readers, articles in East Zone Press, reports by friendly intelligence organizations, and questionnaire debriefings of refugees.

4. This Plan has been revised in order to establish a more secure funding mechanism. In addition, various technical changes have been incorporated in the Plan to bring it into line with current practice.

IV. Approval

5. Funds for the current fiscal year (1957) as of the date of this memorandum were authorized in the amount of \$1.5 million. The fiscal year 1958 program budget contains an estimate of \$1.5 million for that year's operational needs.
