"...b. On or about the 11 August 1948, MARTINI introduced this agent to two representatives of the YUM,

"1. Mr. Vladimir LENAC, residing at SCHLEISSHEIM DP LABOR CAMP (near Munich) block #9, room #23; former address: BELGRAD Pritinska 36; date and place of birth: 23 Oct 1911 - St. Ivan Zelina/Croatia; Occupation: Lawyer; Height: 188 cm; Weight: 140 lbs, medium build; Eyes: blue; Hair: black; Foreign languages: Serbian - fluent; all slavic tongues - fair; Italian - poor; German - poor; employed from 1937 until beginning of the war by Belgrad National Bank, Economical Research Department.;...

"...2. On the 11 August 1948, 1300 hours this agent contacted LENAC and BEGOVIC at 71 Schwanthalerstr., MUNICH and obtained the following information:

"a. The leaders of the YUM ordered LENAC and BEGOVIC to get in touch with US Authorities in reference to organizing a HQs for the YUM in MUNICH or Frankfurt under US supervision and help. The leaders are:

1. LJOTIC, Jakob...
2. PAREZANIN, Ratko...
3. LENAC, Vladimir..."

4. The YUM has no connections with any so called anti-communistic group inside of Yugoslavia. According to Mr. LENAC these groups are very much handicapped because they do not have the financial support needed. Their operations are not very successful because of lack of leadership and experience..."
