1. ODEUM received the following information on 1 September 1949 from its Sub-Organization 66 on the status of their Vladimir LENAC:
 - a. In 1948 LENAC was operating for 66 and furnished information on Yugoslav airfields and fortresses along the Adriatic. At the end of 1948 (sic) he was dropped as operations into Yugoslavia were discontinued.
 - b. LENAC is considered an honest, energetic, and intelligent person.
 - c. LENAC, who is Croatian, was born on 23 October 1911 at Sv. Ivan near Zalina. He is at present living at Munich, Kirchenstrasse 13.
2. Thus, as far as ODEUM goes, they insist that only LENAC, of the Yugoslav personalities mentioned in MGK-A-9283, was employed by ODEUM although ODEUM states it was not aware until the receipt of the information in para. 1 above that he had been dropped. It is entirely possible the Organization has misrepresented to headquarters the date of the dropping of LENAC.
3. ODEUM has the following information on other personalities mentioned in MGK-A-9903 and its annexes:
 - a. GROTHE, Richard - One man with this name was listed in the ODEUM files as working for one SEITHER, of Kufstein (Tyrol), who worked the US Zone of Germany for the BTM and who was supposedly anti-CIC in attitude. Another Richard GROTHE, of Munich (ODEUM is unable to supply an Altmüllerstrasse or any other Munich street address) was

- an ODEUM agent dropped in October 1948 for incompetence and scanty production. He is stated to be an old GLASHOFF man.
- b. In 1946, the latter GROTHE and Rajko PAVLOVIC were arrested by CIC in Munich; the reasons for the arrest are unknown to ODEUM. According to ODEUM information, PAVLOVIC often comes to Munich from Paris.
 - c. COCKOLJICH, alias PASARAC, is unknown at ODEUM.
 - d. ODEUM has extensive information on Tatjana SCHNAUFUSS, nee RAPPOPORT, a Russian Jewess. In 1935, she was engaged in Menshevik activities in Prague. In 1945, she came to Munich, where she has extensive contacts in SECHER and Masonic circles. Her husband, who lives in New York, is said to engage in political (Menshevik?) activities, while Tatjana is Executive Secretary of the Tolstoy Foundation. In Germany she has been screening and selecting Russians for emigration and is suspected of favoring pro-Soviet emigrants. In addition to reported good contacts at the US Consulate in Munich, she is a close friend of Count Georgi GRABBE, Orthodox "High Priest", of Munich, Demonstrace 5 (which may be the "monastery" mentioned in reference annexes.) Tatjana is further said to be strongly anti-SAP.
 - e. The SKRONINSKI of the annexes is presumably identical with the ODEUM SKARZYNSKI reported in MEL-A-154.
