1. (Dr.) Bela LISZKA was first mentioned in UJDROLLERY #305 (Fall PFEIFER) at the 26 October 1954 meeting between PFEIFER and his AVH case officer. In a conversation about Gen. Gustav HENNYEY, PFEIFER listed Dr. LISZKA, the lawyer, as one of the persons employed in HENNYEY's office at Wiedenmeierstr. 49, Munich (Att. 2 to EGLA 12394, 2 February 1955). Then at the 21 July 1955 meeting between PFEIFER and the AVH, his case officer asked him to provide information on Dr. Bela LISZKA.

2. PFEIFER reported the following at the 18 August 1955 meeting:

Dr. LISZKA lives in the same house as HENNYEY's organization. From a conversation with Arpad VITEZ, PFEIFER learned that LISZKA is active for RFE. PFEIFER finally met LISZKA himself in HENNYEY's office and recognized him as the former mayor of Keskemet. LISZKA told PFEIFER that he was an announcer for RFE. In talking about conditions at RFE, LISZKA stated that recently Czechs had been found unfaithful to RFE and decent people must regard these people as easily bought and suspect of espionage. LISZKA said that recently all employees of RFE had to sign an agreement that they would not allow themselves to be employed by any intelligence service. If they were approached by any intelligence agent, they were to report this immediately to the RFE Security Officer. If they did not do this they were subject not only to dismissal but investigation by CIC. (Att. 3 to EGLA 15832, 14 September 1955).

3. FOB files also have < > report on LISZKA contained in EGMA 8322.

4. FOB has no record of Prof. Josef REICHARDT, Hans HUBER, or Baroness Agnes KONRAD.

5. In view of what PFEIFER has told the AVH about LISZKA, it must be kept in mind that the AVH may suspect LISZKA has gone to the RFE Security Officer following their pitch to him, and thus be aware they are dealing with a double agent.
