1. The following additional information concerning Mr. KOVACS has been secured from a reliable source known to []:

"Ferenc KOVACS has a brother named George, but no brother named Attila. George Kovacs is probably connected with Szako, but Ferenc has absolutely no connection with Szako and will not have anything to do with his brother George as a result of his associations. Ferenc is considered absolutely trustworthy, violently antagonistic to Szako, and would never work with him under any circumstances.

"In addition to George Kovacs, six or seven former agents of Ferenc KOVACS are now in the employ of Szako. Two or three of these went with him only out of necessity to support themselves, and through them, KOVACS has access to inside information from the Szako group. If Ferenc can still be reached, he should be the best available source of Hungarian military information."

2. As requested in referenced conversation, we also attach hereto the most recent report on Hungary by Mr. Zoltan Pfeiffer. We would appreciate your comments as to the reportability of the information contained in the report.

1. The information below is a further sample of the kind of information now being received by HORTHY from a member of the MHPK on an informal basis:

December 31: No change in Hungary with respect to Soviet forces. Three tank divisions located as follows: around Szombathely and the western border; north of Lake Balaton; and near Kecskemet.

There is no special action evident as to preparations against TITO from any adjacent satellite countries. TITO counts on political advantages by referring to his country being in danger.

January 29: Violations of the military restrictions of the peace treaty include the following:

- (1) Three classes of Hungarians, at least forty thousand each, presently are in arms. Total 120,000.
- (2) T-34 tanks appeared publicly in Budapest in May 1950.
- (3) Hungarian Airforce has over 200 planes.
