MEMORANDUM FOR: CHIEF, POLITICAL AND PSYCHOLOGICAL WARFARE

SUBJECT: Magyar Harcosok Bajtársi Közössége (MHBK)
(Fraternal Unity of Hungarian Veterans)

REFERENCE: Memorandum to Chief, Political and Psychological Warfare from [] (PAD/2), same subject, dated 11 December 1952

1. The Hungarian Branch, EE, has no intention of supporting the MHBK, a Hungarian refugee organization headed by Andras ZAKO.
2. The conversation to which [] referred dealt with various methods of counteracting the MHBK, and particularly of forcing the MHBK to cease marketing fabricated intelligence - an activity which has been the main source of income for the MHBK for many years. One of the methods discussed was to cooperate with the French in wresting leadership of the MHBK from ZAKO, and eliminating that part of the organization responsible for flooding Western intelligence agencies with spurious information. As [] was informed, however, the Hungarian Branch does not now have facilities for embarking on a project of this scope.
3. The Hungarian Branch, EE, made an extensive study of the MHBK and its fabrication activities in 1950. Since that time the Branch has advised American and other Western intelligence agencies against collaboration with the MHBK. Members of the MHBK engaged in fabrication are being systematically "burned". This effort has consumed a considerable amount of time but has succeeded in preventing the MHBK from obtaining full support from any of the Western intelligence agencies.
