1. ZIPPER informs us, on what they claim to be reliable authority, that ZAKO has reached an agreement with the Yugoslav IS, and recently visited Yugoslavia, and inspected refugee camps there, under the auspices of the YIS. This was news to us, so we forward it on the chance that it is news to addressees. The implication would seem to be that ZAKO will shortly commence receiving Hungarian refugees from Yugoslavia with which to enhance his intelligence product. ZAKO was accompanied by Albin KAPITANFFY.

2. Other than this, our only news of the aging General is that he is still being utilized by OSI (Air Force CIC) MUNICH, about which we have expressed our considerable reservations without apparent effect.
