Subject: Self-protection of the MHEK (General ZAKO)

- RE: 1) Co-operation between the Yugoslav and Soviet intelligence service.
- 2) Co-operation between ZAKO and ABAY on the one side and the Yugoslav intelligence service on the other side.

This office is in possession of information which was obtained from the Bavarian LfV according to which

- 1) the Yugoslav intelligence service allegedly co-operates with the Soviet intelligence service,
- 2) ex-general ~~ZAKO~~ co-operates with the Yugoslav intelligence service for which purpose he makes use in the Federal Republic of a certain Kalman ~~ABAY~~ whose name was formerly Koloman ~~MILDSCHUETZ~~.

While the Bavarian LfV does not doubt the correctness of this information, it can for the time being only be evaluated by the BfV as an F/6 information. The Bavarian LfV was asked to inform this office of its access to the information and of the way in which it was obtained.

The BfV would appreciate being informed as early as possible whether you are in possession of information concerning this report and how your office would evaluate the information contained therein.
